## Welcome to Spring Shoot 2025 at Grand Valley Cap N Ballers™

We are pleased that you have chosen to join us for a full weekend of shooting.

**Registration:** Registration is \$25.00 per individual or \$30.00 per family (self, spouse and children 17 and under). Space is available for both primitive and modern camping with water and firewood available. Limited electricity is also offered on a first come first served basis at \$10.00 for the weekend. Trading is included in registration, however traders may call Dawn Thurkettle at (616-323-7373) to reserve a specific site.

**Please note that GVCNB welcomes all primitive shooters/campers, with primitive camping for non-shooters only at \$10.00.** All persons occupying a campsite must register, whether shooting or not.

**NOTE:** There will be no kitchen service available for this event. Coffee and water will be available at the clubhouse. We will be having a potluck on Saturday evening at 6:00 pm. Please bring a dish to share and enjoy the fellowship time. **NO TRADERS FEE HOWEVER IF YOU WANT TO COMPETE YOU MUST REGISTER**

**Pets:** Owners are responsible for taking care of their pets and cleaning up after them. Pets must be kept quiet and are not allowed to run freely. Failure to abide by these rules will result in the owner being asked to remove the pet.

**PRIMITIVE PROGRAM:** Friday and Saturday's program (9am – 3pm) will consist of a 20 shot woods walk, which will be self-scored. These matches may be shot with any traditional firearm. Divisions for men, women, trade gun, and juniors (17 & under): flint and percussion: open sites only, except junior matches. As in the past we will have hawk and knife competition at the throwing range from 1pm to 3pm on Saturday.

**LINE MATCHES:** "Any line match any time" on Friday and Saturday. Relays are 25 minutes. (pistol shooters may use 2 relays). NMLRA rules are used unless otherwise noted.

**SHOTGUN:** Shotgun registration is \$25.00/individual or \$30.00/family includes a 15-bird skeet or trap match, along with skeet and trap re-entry matches.
