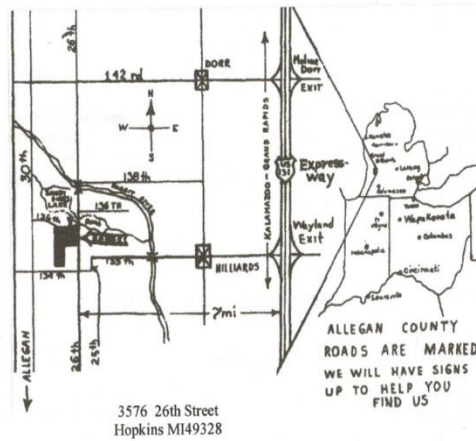

WELCOME MUZZLE LOADERS

For more than 50 years, GVCNB has presented one of the largest and best muzzle loading events in the Midwest. When you come to shoot at GVCNB, you will find something for competitors at all ages and experience—line, line primitive and silhouette matches, a complete shotgun program and much more. In addition, our off-hand bench, and shotgun ranges are covered. Meals will be available at our clubhouse as will ice cream.

REGISTRATION: Rifle, Pistol, etc.: A fee of \$30 per individual or \$40 per family (husband, wife, all children 17 and under) covers all regular matches, prize drawings, and setting up as a trader. Each competitor must request his/her targets separately. To pre-order targets and/or to reserve a specific trading site send your request, before July 20 to Dawn Thurkettle, PO box 14, Dorr, Mi. 49323. Targets will then be waiting for you at the target shack. Each competitor may shoot as many matches as he or she is eligible for, but we respectfully request that you do not ask for you will not use, or for matches you are not legible to shoot. In addition, each registered shooter will receive a ticket to be placed in a drawing for door prizes!

To register as a shotgunner only fees are \$15.00 per individual or \$25.00 per family. Registration is necessary to receive targets. In addition. If you also plan to shoot rifle and pistol and additional fee of \$15.00 individual and \$15 per family is necessary to receive targets

CAMPING: Both primitive and modern camping are available, and primitive non-shooters may register for \$10. You will find firewood and plenty of water available. Limited electricity is also available (no air conditioners) on a first come first serve basis at \$10. **All persons occupying a campsite must register, weather shooting or not.**

PETS: Owners are responsible for taking care and cleaning up after their pets. Pets must be kept quiet and no allowed to roam freely. Failure to abide by these rules will result in the owner being asked to remove the pet.

PLEASE NOTE

Trade guns must be flint licks at least 54 caliber without rear sight above the plane of the barrel and having a simple trigger. Line matches may be shot any match any time each day. Competitors are responsible stapling, posting and pulling their targets. **Please remove staples before turning in targets.** Offhand relays are 20 minutes. Bench and X sticks matches at the high range are 25 minutes. Sight shades may be used. Pistol and revolvers require a one-hand hold. Matches 4 thru 47 will pay 3 places.

One (1) target per relay and target must be removed after each relay except Pistol and Revolver.

PRIMITIVE PROGRAM

Primitive matches must be shot with traditional style arms having open sights and no shades. Participants must have a competitor number before competing. All stations are two (2) shots. Three (3) falls of the hammer counts as a shot.

FRIDAY, THERE ARE FIVE (5) DIVISIONS: Percussion, Flint, Trade Gun Women's and juniors thru age 17. There are 20 shots – 2 at each station plus a tiebreaker. Points will be added period clothing. You must make a separate trip for each division. Scoring is an aggregate of the entire course.

SATURDAY: Woods walk – Each station is a separate match. No points for costume. Tradition rifle and Trade Guns only.

3 places will not be paid if less than 3 competitors in any match
