

DIRECTIONS: From Grand Rapids Michigan take US131 south to the Dorr exit which is  $142^{nd}$  Avenue and go west 6  $\frac{1}{2}$  miles to 26<sup>th</sup> Street and go south 3 miles to the club grounds.

DIRECTIONS: From Kalamazoo Michigan take US131 north to the Dorr exit which is  $142^{nd}$  Avenue and go west 6  $\frac{1}{2}$  miles to  $26^{th}$  Street and go south 3 miles to the club grounds.

DIRECTIONS: From St. Joe/Benton Harbor, Michigan area take I94 to I 196 towards Grand Rapids, Michigan to M-89 exit. (Exit 34 toward Fennville), turn right on M-89/124<sup>th</sup> Avenue and continue to follow M-89. Turn left onto M-40, turn right onto 128<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Turn left onto 30<sup>th</sup> Street, turn right onto 134<sup>th</sup> Avenue, turn left onto 26<sup>th</sup> Street. The club is on the left.
