# Welcome Muzzle Loaders!

For 63 years, GVCNB is proud to offer our signature Frontier Shoot, where shooters of all skill levels can enjoy line matches, primitive shooting, archery and shotgun matches.

**Registration:** \$35 per individual and \$45 per family (children under 17). Registration covers all regular matches and one entry for a door prize.

Camping Available: \$10.00 for primitive & modern camping and \$10.00 additional for electricity. Firewood and water available. No air conditioning hook up at main camp.

Pet Policy: Pets are welcome. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after pets. Pets must be on a leash at all times.

**Line Match Program:** Trade guns must be flint locks at least 54 caliber and without rear sights. Matches will be "Any Match, Any Time." Offhand relays are 25 minutes. Bench and X Stix matches at high range are 25 minutes. Pistols and revolvers must be loaded from a stand and require one hand hold. Matches pay three places. One target per relay.

**Primitive Camp Program:** Traditional firearms only. All stations are 2 shots for a 20 shot match. Divisions include: percussion, flint, trade gun, men, women's and juniors. Period clothing points will be awarded for tie breakers. Rides available from primitive camp to main camp.

Friday's program will be matches in five divisions of percussion, flint, trade gun for men, women and juniors. Aggregate scoring for all matches. Saturday's program is the Woods Walk. Trade gun and traditional rifles only.

**Shot Gun Program:** Shooting hours available Thursday, Friday and Saturday. (See schedule of events) NMLRA rules apply unless otherwise noted. The following matches are covered by initial entry free:

- Men's Championship 10 birds @ 10yd, 16yd & 5 birds @ 20 yd
- Ladies Championship 10 birds @ 10yd, 16yd & 5 birds @ 20 yd
- Junior Championship 10 birds @ 10yd, 16yd & 5 birds @ 20 yd

All other matches held require re-entry fee. A shoot off will be held at 3:30pm on Saturday for tied matches.
