\$25 per individual and \$30 per family (includes children under 17). Registration includes line, primitive, shotgun, trap and archery matches.

Camping Available

\$10.00 for primitive & modern camping and \$10.00 Additional for electricity. Firewood and water available. No air conditioning hook up at main camp.

Pet Policy

Pets are welcome. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after pets. Pets must be on a leash at all times.

Primitive Program: On Friday & Saturday a 20 shot long hunter range course consisting of metal targets will be available & self scored. Any traditional firearm may be use for these matches. Prizes for paid three places to men, women & juniors (17 & under) divisions. Hawk & knife matches on Saturday.

Line Matches Program: "Any Match. Any Time" on Friday & Saturday. Relays are 25 minutes and pistol shooters may use two relays. NMLRA rules apply unless otherwise advised by the range officer. Aggregates pay three places.

Shotgun Program: 10- 15 bird matches at multiple yards, skeet singles and skeet doubles available for men, women and juniors. Re-entry matches available.
